Fast and Abstinence and Other Acts of Penance Lent 2018

The Bishops of the U.S. prescribe as minimal obligation:

- ◇ All persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- ◇ All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals are to be light.
- ◇ All faithful are encouraged to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions and education programs.
- ◇ All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl.
