SEMI-ANNUAL PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE, MARCH 1 AND 2, 2025

On behalf of the Parish Finance Council and Monsignor Gentili, I am pleased to present our Semi-Annual Financial Update. Please know that we are profoundly grateful for the spiritual and financial support continually demonstrated by our parishioners. Your support is truly a source of inspiration to us all.

As mentioned in our report last September, our new Sunday collection goal is \$36,000 per week. This increase is necessary to pay for the costs to maintain our day-to-day operations attributable to our dedicated staff and our beautiful parish campus. A number of expenses have increased since last September: including property insurance, salaries, medical insurance and utilities, to name a few. We hope to achieve this new weekly collection goal during this fiscal year with our strong financial oversight and *your* help.

We are **34 weeks** into the fiscal year, which ends on June 30. Our weekly collection continues to slowly grow, with an average weekly collection of \$32,747, a 3.8% increase over last year. In addition, thanks to your generosity, our long-term mortgage debt has been reduced to \$5.9 million dollars from the original loan of \$12.5 million dollars in 2011.

If you have not already done so, we encourage you to sign up *today* for *Parish Giving*, our electronic offertory program (egiving), which currently represents 55% of parishioner contributions received on a weekly basis. We would like to increase egiving to 65% of parishioners who contribute by this time next year. We are pleased to offer the Parish Giving app, the link on the website and the QR code to donate easily. The QR code can be found in the bulletin, on the Narthex monitors during mass and on the bottom of your screen during livestream. To those who contribute *cash*, we respectfully ask that you consider transitioning to Parish Giving as well.

Our Parish benefits greatly by being able to count on that same level of financial support, each and every week. In the end, we appreciate whatever method you choose to consistently give to **your** parish. If you are fortunate enough to find yourself in a position to increase your contribution by 5%, we kindly ask you to consider doing so to help us meet the increase in our expenses.

Our Stewardship Campaign, once again, was a *tremendous success* and exceeded last year's total. We surpassed our \$150,000 goal by raising \$220,739. We are so grateful to the 436 parish families who participated. These financial resources
