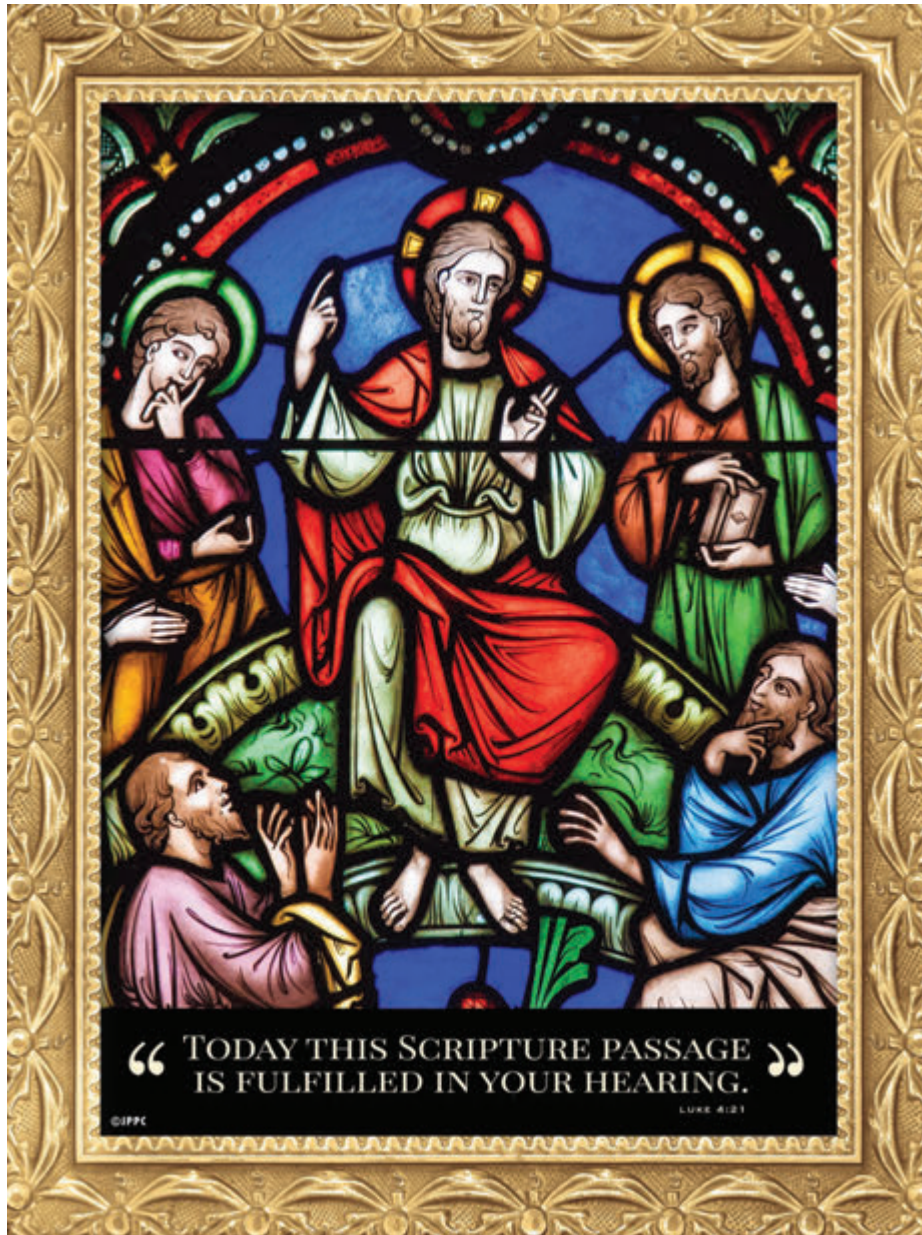

FROM THE PASTOR

U.S. BISHOPS DECRY COURT RULING AGAINST HHS MANDATE EXEMPTION

January 16, 2019

In response to the January 14, 2019, federal court ruling from Pennsylvania granting a nationwide injunction barring the broadened moral and religious exemption to the HHS mandate, Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo of Galveston-Houston, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City in Kansas, Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, and Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of Louisville, Chairman of the USCCB Committee for Religious Liberty, issued the following statement:

“Yesterday’s court ruling freezing these common-sense regulations leaves those with conscientious or religious objections to the HHS mandate out in the cold. In a free country, no one should be forced to facilitate or fund things like contraception, sterilization, and abortion-inducing drugs and devices, which go against their core beliefs. We pray that this decision will be appealed and that future courts will respect the free exercise arguments of the Little Sisters of the Poor and so many others who simply seek the freedom to serve their neighbors without the threat of massive government fines hanging over their heads.”

MARCHING FOR LIFE, 2019

In his most recent column Archbishop Chaput writes, “This month marks the 46th anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* Supreme court decision, which effectively legalized abortion on demand. It also marks another annual March for Life, this year on January 18. It’s a time to look back and look ahead. The abortion struggle of the past four decades teaches a very useful lesson. Evil talks a lot about “tolerance” when it’s weak. When evil is strong, real tolerance gets pushed out the door. And the reason is simple. Evil cannot bear the counter-witness of truth. It will not coexist peacefully with goodness, because evil insists on being seen as right, and *worshiped* as being right. Therefore, the good must be made to seem hateful and wrong.”

REV. WALTER J. QUINN, O.S.A.

August 8, 1930 – January 15, 2019

Rev. Walther J. Quinn, O.S.A., who recently passed away, was an active part of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish for approximately 10 years from 2006 to 2016. Father Quinn will be greatly missed by parishioners, clergy and staff at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish.



Father was a 1948 graduate of West Catholic Boys High School in Philadelphia. He attended the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania, obtaining a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics in 1952. He then served in the United States Army from 1952-1954 during the Korean War. After the war, Father worked as a salesman for the firm that invented the coffee dispensing machine in PA, NJ, DE from 1954-1955.

Father entered the Augustinian Order and was received as a Novice on September 9, 1955. After one year at Good Counsel Novitiate at New Hamburg, NY, he professed his first vows on September 10, 1956. He was ordained to the Priesthood in 1961 at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC by Bishop Philip J. Hannan.
