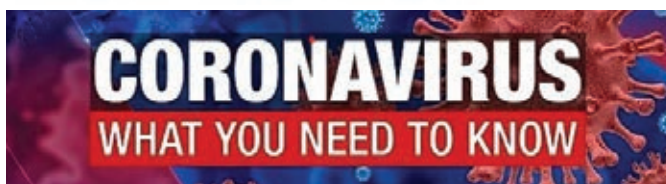

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

When you are unable to attend Mass you can make a spiritual communion. This is a devotion we can perform on our own whether we are at Mass and not receiving the Eucharist sacramentally or if we are anywhere else. This can be done while watching a broadcast of the Mass on the Internet or even in our morning or evening prayers.

*My Jesus, I believe that You are in the Blessed Sacrament.
I love You above all things, and I long for You in my soul.
Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.*

*As though You have already come,
I embrace You and unite myself entirely to You;
never permit me to be separated from You.*

1 Make an act of faith
Come up with your own prayer or use a traditional one to express to the Lord our faith in his real presence in the Eucharist.

2 Make an act of love
Say a prayer that expresses your love and gratitude to the Lord. Thank Him for his infinite love as well.

4 steps for Spiritual Communion

3 Express your desire to receive him
As you are not able to physically receive the Lord, express your desire to receive Him in your heart.

4 Invite Jesus to come into your heart
With a humble and contrite heart we ask the Lord to come to us just as He would if we were able to receive the sacrament.

PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE SICK WITH CORONAVIRUS, HEALTH AGENTS, CAREGIVERS AND FAITHFUL

DECREE OF POPE FRANCIS

March 20, 2020

The Holy Father is granting a Plenary Indulgence to the faithful sick with coronavirus, to health agents, relatives and all those taking care of the sick, who expose themselves to the risk of infection.



On Friday, March 20, 2020, the Holy See published the Decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary, regarding special indulgences for the faithful in the present pandemic crisis. Cardinal Mauro Piacenza, Major Penitentiary, and Krzysztof Nykiel, Regent, signed the Decree on March 19.

The persons that will benefit from the Plenary Indulgence are the sick at home or in hospital, in quarantine by order of the Health Authority, “if, with a spirit detached from any sin, join spiritually through the media in the celebration of Holy Mass, the prayer of the Rosary, the pious practice of the *Via Crucis* or other forms of devotion, or if at least they pray the Creed, the Our Father and an invocation to the Most Holy Virgin Mary, offering this trial with a spirit of faith in God and charity to brethren.”

Always “with the will to fulfill the usual conditions (Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer) for the intentions of the Holy Father, as soon as it is possible,” states the Decree.

Health Agents and Carers

The Plenary Indulgence can be obtained by health agents, their relatives and all those that, “following the example of the Good Samaritan, expose themselves to the risk of infection, by caring for the sick with Coronavirus, and fulfilling the same conditions.”

Given the present global epidemic, the Apostolic Penitentiary also grants the Plenary Indulgence, with the same conditions, to “those faithful that visit the Most Blessed Sacrament, engage in Eucharistic Adoration, or read Sacred Scripture for at least half an hour, or pray the Holy Rosary, or do the pious exercise of the *Via Crucis*, or pray the Divine Mercy chaplet, to implore Almighty God for an end to the epidemic, relief for the afflicted and eternal salvation for those the Lord has called to Himself.”

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT - THE HEALING POWER OF ABSOLUTION

Ezekiel 37:12-14

"I will open your graves." As it comes closer to the Passion of Jesus, Lent raises the penitent sinner's hope to unmeasurable levels. Even if one is spiritually dead because of his guilt, the living God is greater than death and his power is mightier than any earthly decay. Nowhere in the Old Covenant – the outline we've been following in Lent from Adam and Eve, to Abram, to Moses, to David – is this expressed more clearly than in the first reading, Ezekiel's vision of dry bones scattered in a field that are clothed with flesh and rise again to form a powerful army. Wisdom says that God "does not rejoice in the destruction of the living, for he fashioned all things that they might have being" (Wis 1:13b-14a). By turning away from the living God, Israel has hurled itself into death, but God's vitality is stronger and can give life and strength back to dead bones.

By receiving Absolution, the sinner is absolved from his sins. They are gone, are no longer there. Hence from now on any further consideration of them is eclipsed; they have been extinguished, have disappeared, and have been submerged totally in the Passion of the Lord. They are now like a memory for which we no longer have room because all our interior space is needed to accept the fullness of grace, a grace of totality, of the invisible God, a grace that not only fills us and restores us to where we once were, but expands us as well. It penetrates us, lays claim to the space already there, and creates a new space. The content is larger than the vessel. Mercy is overabundant, and so receiving mercy always expands us from within.

Easter Giving Tree Helps the Needy

Did you know that Philadelphia has the highest rate of deep poverty in the United States? Living in deep poverty translates into an **annual** income of \$6,380 for an individual and \$13,100 for a family of four. Face to Face provides services to reduce the suffering caused by poverty. They offer a soup kitchen, legal, health and social services. By taking an egg from the Easter Giving Tree you can help provide: a week of healthy meals to reduce hunger (\$50); ID so the client can gain access to employment, housing and benefits (\$30.50); a visit to the health center to heal the sick (\$25); or a hot shower for the homeless (\$10). If you couldn't get an egg, you can still donate. *Checks payable to Face to Face*

The 3rd Annual Poor Man's Supper will hopefully be rescheduled for a future date. Many thanks to those that were already signed up to support the dinner. Look for future communication through the church bulletin.

OLG BLOOD DRIVE HUGE SUCCESS

The projected goal for the parish Blood Drive on Wednesday, March 18 was 76 units. At our drive, the American Red Cross (ARC) collected 80 units of whole blood and 15 units of power (x 2) red cells for an equivalent of 110 units. This was 144.7% of the projected goal. Thank you to everyone who donated blood and supported this Blood Drive.

Due to COVID-19, there were only four Blood Drives last Wednesday instead of the typical 30 or more. These four drives, combined with the six fixed-collection sites in the Greater Philadelphia Region, collected a total of 416 units on Wednesday. That means that our drive accounted for more than 25% of the blood collected in the area. The ARC needs a minimum of 600 units a day to meet the average need of the local hospitals. This does not take into account that the ARC was working under a nationwide shortage before COVID-19.

The Pennsylvania Catholic Conference continues to communicate with members of the state Senate to make sure that the pending Telemedicine bill (SB 857) is passed in its pro-life form, which prohibits the use of Telemedicine for abortion.

Contact your senator and ask them to reject this new version of the bill and only support the "pro-life" telemedicine bill (SB 87) as passed by the House of Representatives.

SB 857 is a Telemedicine bill that allows for remote treatment of patients by doctors. While we support this, abortion proponents want to misuse telemedicine to perform chemical abortions. A third of all abortions in the state are done chemically. Using Telemedicine for abortions is a stated goal for Planned Parenthood because they can do more chemical abortions with fewer doctors and less overhead costs.

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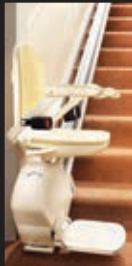
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
