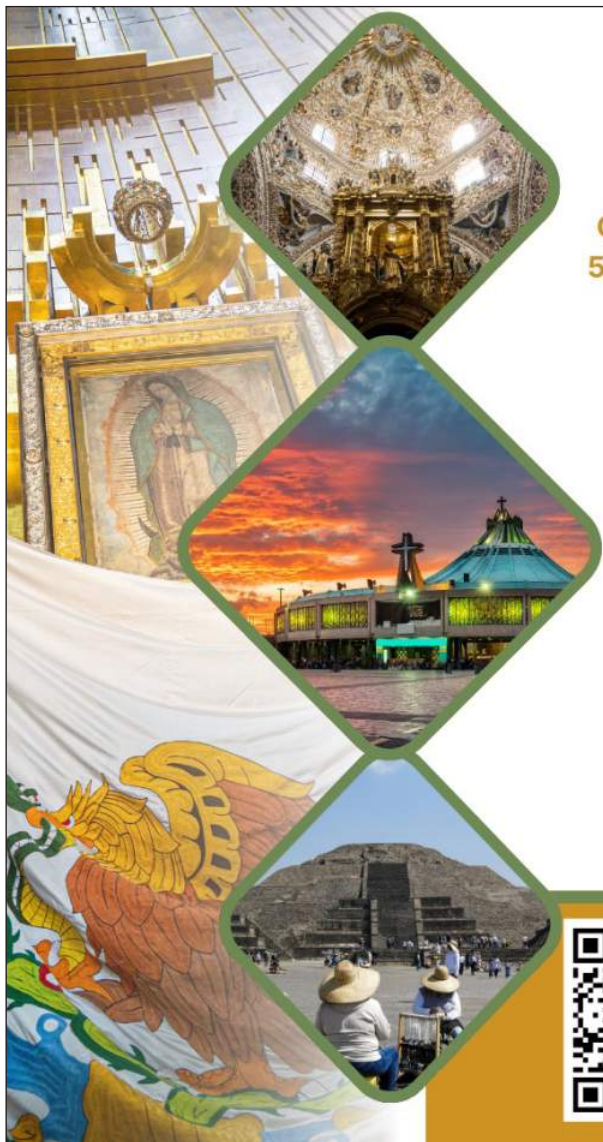

POPE LEO WILL CANONIZE TWO AMAZING MILLENNIAL MEN AS SAINTS

Venerate Their Relics and Receive Their Holy Cards
This Weekend, Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine, OLG Church



Saint Carlo Acutis died October 12, 2006 at the age of 15 from leukemia. Carlo's parents were non-practicing Catholics. His father was an agnostic. Carlo began practicing his faith at the age of four with his nan-

ny. Carlo is known for his love of the Eucharist and his use of technology to promote the Catholic faith. He is responsible for creating a website documenting all Eucharistic Miracles, as well as the Eucharistic Miracles display that we have here at OLG every November. He is the first canonized saint to have a cell phone and wear Nike sneakers. One of his famous quotes is, "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven."

Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati died on July 4, 1925, at the age of 24 from polio. Pier Giorgio was known for his joy, jokes, athleticism, care for the poor and needy, political activism, selflessness and always challenging his friends to a life of virtue. Pier's parents were non-practicing Catholics and agnostics. He is regarded as the patron of students (mainly because he wasn't good at school), young Catholics, mountaineers, youth groups and World Youth Day. Pope John Paul II called him the "man of beatitudes."

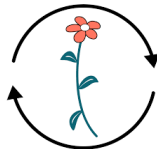

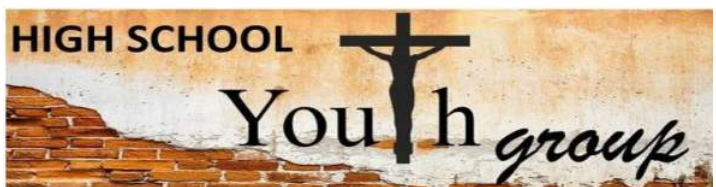
