ARCHBISHOP PÉREZ REMARKS AT LIBERTY MEDAL CEREMONY AT THE NATIONAL CONSTITUTION CENTER

His work as a priest, bishop, Cardinal, and now Shepherd of the Universal Church has always focused on uplifting the inherent dignity of all people and building pathways to peace.

Philly is proud that the pope is a graduate of Villanova University who spent time living and working in our region. Pope Leo knows us and we feel like we know him. What is a Patronal Feast? / ¿Que es un Fiesta Patronal?

Celebrating a Feast Day

As Catholics we also celebrate many feasts associated with our faith. Some are feasts specifically associated with a parish or church. We frequently honor the day on which a church's altar was consecrated as a special anniversary. The year in which a parish was erected is often engraved in the cornerstone of the Church building. And the Patron Saint of a particular parish is an important annual Feast Day for the parish.

A Parish "Feast Day"

So what day is considered a parish's special feast day? The following is an explanation on the history of honoring of the consecration and dedication of a church:

"The practice of dedicating Churches dates from Apostolic times and ... the observance of the anniversary of a Church's Dedication can be traced back to the days of Constantine. When churches are dedicated, the congregation is placed under the protection of some saint, a special devotion to some mystery, or to some manifestation of God's love and thus, the church takes the name of the saint or an apparition to keep that mystery or mark of love always before the people of the parish: In our instance, Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The intention in so naming churches is, that the people should have special love for the Patron Saint; that they should place themselves under their protection, and, by the study and imitation of their life, make themselves worthy of their intercession before God. The people are also called to honor the mystery or mark of divine love or divine object. The people are also called to have great veneration and love for the mystery, mark or object commemorated by the church's name.

Therefore, the saint or devotion, in whose honor the church is named, becomes the Patron Saint of the place, and this Feast is called the Patronal Feast.

This Patron Saint is also the one under whose special protection a Church is placed for the good of the community.

How to Honor a Patronal Feast

The community is called to come together to celebrate and invoke their Patron (*Patroness*) by:

- † Celebrating the Feast Day of the Patron - **December 12th**
- † Hold a Novena (*Nine days of prayer*) for the Patron **December 3rd to the 11th**
- † Venerate and/or visually honor the Shine of Guadalupe
- † Pray for the Patronage protection of the Unborn
- † Invoking and honoring the Patron in prayer at Mass
- † Study the apparition of the Patron



Celebrando la Fiesta Patronal

Como Católicos, también celebramos muchas fiestas relacionadas con nuestra fe. Algunas están vinculadas específicamente a una parroquia o iglesia. Con frecuencia conmemoramos el aniversario especial del día en que se consagró el Altar de una iglesia. Al igual el año que la parroquia fue erigida cual aparece grabada en la piedra angular del edificio de la iglesia; asimismo, la Fiesta Patronal del Santo constituye una celebración anual importante para la parroquia.

La "Fiesta Patronal" de la Parroquia

¿Qué día se considera, entonces, la Fiesta Patronal de una parroquia? La siguiente es la explicación sobre la historia de la consagración y dedicación de una iglesia:

"La práctica de dedicar iglesias se remonta a los tiempos apostólicos y... la celebración del aniversario de la dedicación de una iglesia puede rastrearse hasta la época de Constantino. Al dedicar las iglesias, la comunidad queda bajo el amparo de un santo, de una devoción especial a un misterio o de alguna manifestación del amor de Dios; así, el templo adopta el nombre de dicho santo o de una aparición para mantener presente ante los fieles de la parroquia ese misterio o esa señal de amor. En nuestro caso, es Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe.

La intención al dar estos nombres a las iglesias es que los fieles profesen un amor especial hacia el Patron (santo), se acojan bajo su protección y, mediante el estudio del santo y la imitación de su vida, se hagan dignos de la intercesión del santo ante Dios.

Asimismo, se invita a los fieles a honrar el misterio o la manifestación del amor divino o la realidad sagrada que dicho objeto divino evoca, sintiendo gran veneración y amor por aquello que se conmemora con el nombre de la Iglesia.

Por lo tanto, el santo o la advocación a cuyo honor se dedica la iglesia se convierte en el Patrón del lugar, y la celebración de la Fiesta correspondiente recibe el nombre de Fiesta Patronal.

Este Patrón es, además, aquel bajo cuya protección se encomienda la Iglesia especialmente para el bien de la comunidad.

Cómo Honrar la Fiesta Patronal

La comunidad es llamada a unirse para celebrar e invocar a su Patrón (o *Patrona*) mediante:

- † La celebración de la fiesta del Patrón - **12 de diciembre**
- † Hacer la novena (*nueve días de oración*) en honor al Patrón **Del 3 al 11 de diciembre**
- † La veneración y/o homenaje visual al Santuario de Guadalupe
- † Orar pidiendo la protección del Patrón para los no nacidos
- † La invocación y homenaje al Patrón en oración durante la Misa
- † El estudio de la aparición del Patrón

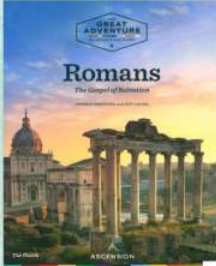

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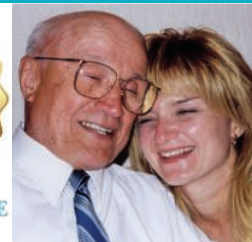
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
