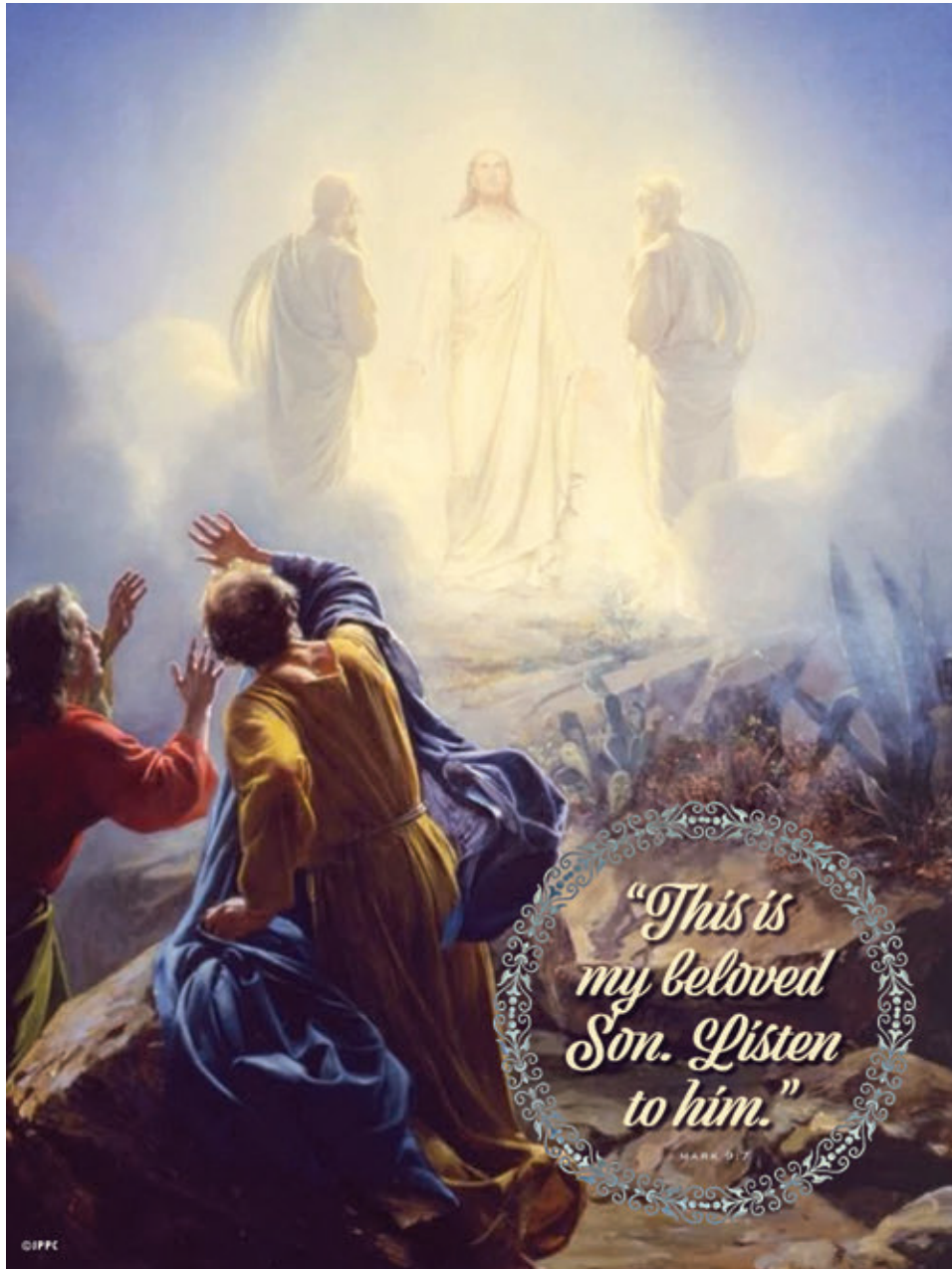

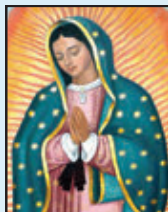

WHAT MAKES FOR A GOOD HOMILY?

Your insights on this question are sought through a national study partially funded by a grant from the Confraternity of Christian Faith of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Catholic Biblical Association. FAST AND ABSTINENCE & OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT

The Bishops of the United States prescribe that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday (with the exception of Friday, March 19, The Solemnity of St. Joseph). All persons age 18 to 59, should limit themselves to a single full meal (and two light meals) on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions and education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended. All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl.

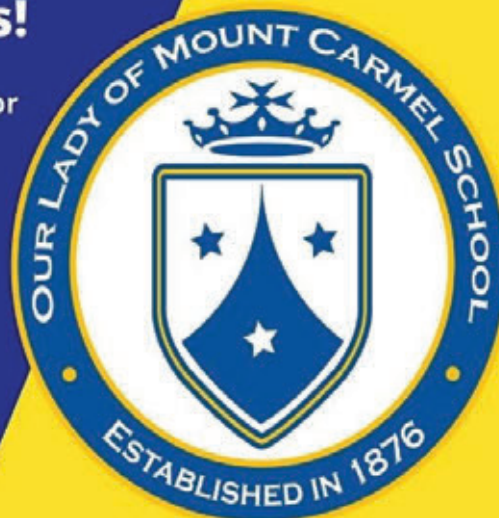
