

SEMI-ANNUAL PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

OCTOBER 3-4, 2020

On behalf of the Parish Finance Council, I am pleased to present our semi-annual update.

First, the spiritual and financial support demonstrated by our parishioners is simply outstanding, especially during these last several months with the pandemic. Know that we are truly grateful.

Second, our **Fiscal Year** ended on June 30, 2020 and we have good news to report in many areas. Our average weekly collection for the year was **\$29,807**, a **3.6 %** increase over the prior year. Due to careful stewardship of our resources, our income once again exceeded our expenses, allowing us to fund our many fine ministries and other important parish projects, such as the use of technology for outreach, evangelization and livestreaming of mass, as well as, investment in the camera system for the safety and security of our campus.

Third, we would like to update you on the status of our mortgage. In October 2018, our debt was \$10.3 million with the Archdiocese. At the Archdiocese's request, we needed to begin self-funding our mortgage as soon as possible. In April 2019, we began our mortgage relationship with Penn Community Bank. **In April 2020, we were able to renegotiate the terms of our loan due to the current interest rate environment and the pandemic. Today, our debt balance is just under \$9 million.** It is important to note that we have a balloon payment of \$2.4 million due on the mortgage in May of 2024.

Fourth, in previous updates we have stressed that we must increase our Sunday collections to **\$32,000 per week by June 30, 2021** to maintain our financial solvency. We are **13 weeks** into the current fiscal year and our average weekly collection is **\$29,944**, a **5.6%** increase over last year at this point in time. Knowing that the pandemic has caused financial hardships for many, our primary request today is for each parishioner to convert to our parish electronic giving program. We are so thankful to the 257 families that have transitioned to this easy, safe and secure method of financially supporting OLG, especially those that have enrolled since the pandemic began.

Just like those of us who benefit from the consistency of a weekly paycheck or monthly social security benefit, our parish would benefit greatly by being able to count on that same level of financial security each and every week. Details on the e-giving program can be found on this page and on the parish website. Our Parish Finance Council will be embarking on an initiative in the coming weeks to reach out directly to seek your support of this very important parish goal.

Your spiritual and financial support enables all of us to realize our Parish Vision. For that, we humbly thank you.



THE TRUE STORY OF KERMIT GOSNELL




LECTIO: PHILIPPIANS


