FROM THE PASTOR

PASTORAL MESSAGE OF ARCHBISHOP NELSON J. PÉREZ REGARDING MATTERS OF IMMIGRATION



Recent news reports detailing the arrest of immigrants throughout the country, including the Philadelphia region, have produced a great deal of fear and unleashed a broad range of other emotions. These events have impacted the migrant community in deeply troubling ways. I am witnessing your sorrow with great sadness and concern as are people of goodwill from all walks of life.

As the son of immigrants, I have found recent events particularly heartbreaking. Today, I write to express my prayerful solidarity, and that of our local Church, with you. You are not alone. The Church is a community of faith, and the divine person of Christ, who was forced to flee his homeland as a child, holds you in his compassionate arms.

As Catholics, we believe our eternal homeland is heaven, and that as citizens of earth, the dignity of every person means everyone should have a safe place to live, with the opportunity to work for a just wage. Many of you came to the United States seeking new opportunities far away from oppressive regimes and endured difficult and dangerous circumstances to start life anew here. Your presence and your contributions to society through hard work and upright living are a blessing to our country and to our Church. No one should be forced to live in fear of unjust persecution.

I encourage you to remain close with the members of your parish communities and the priests who provide you with pastoral care.

We recognize that our country is rightly safeguarded by law enforcement officials. They uphold the common good by protecting all of us from human trafficking, the exploitation of children, and any other criminal offense against human dignity. At the same time, we strongly advocate for immigration policies that guarantee the protection of life, liberty, and property of all those who call the United States of America home, natural born citizens and those working toward citizenship alike.

While there is no instant solution to the challenges pervading immigration policy, I urge everyone in parish communities to unite through prayer and social unity with the immigrant faithful under the leadership of parish pastors.

The Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph cared for the child Jesus in the mystery of the flight into Egypt and their intercession is with us today. I pray with you and for you that you experience the protection of God.

May our Lord bless our country with peace and inspire comprehensive immigration reform that respects the law and provides meaningful opportunities for all those who wish to call the United States of America their home.

En una carta pastoral del 23 de julio, el arzobispo Nelson Pérez expresa profunda tristeza y solidaridad en oración, haciendo un llamado a los católicos para que se unan en apoyo a la comunidad migrante y aboguen por una reforma migratoria integral.



Dear Queridos hermanas y hermanos en Cristo:

Informes recientes de noticias que detallan el arresto de inmigrantes en todo el país, incluida la región de Filadelfia, han producido un gran temor y desatado una amplia gama de otras emociones. Estos eventos han impactado a la comunidad migrante de maneras profundamente preocupantes. Estoy presenciando su dolor con gran tristeza y preocupación, al igual que las personas de buena voluntad de todos los ámbitos sociales.

Como hijo de inmigrantes, he encontrado los acontecimientos recientes especialmente desgarradores. Hoy les escribo para expresarles mi solidaridad, y la de nuestra Iglesia local, en la oración. Ustedes no están solos; la Iglesia es una comunidad de fe, y la persona divina de Cristo, que se vio obligada a huir de su tierra natal cuando era niño, los sostiene en sus brazos compasivos.

Como católicos creemos que nuestra patria eterna es el cielo, y que, como ciudadanos de la tierra, la dignidad de cada persona significa que todos deberían tener un lugar seguro para vivir, con la oportunidad de trabajar por un salario justo. Muchos de ustedes vinieron a Estados Unidos buscando nuevas oportunidades lejos de los régimen opresivos y superaron circunstancias difíciles y peligrosas para comenzar la vida de nuevo aquí; su presencia y contribuciones a la sociedad a través del trabajo duro y una vida recta son una bendición para nuestro país y para nuestra Iglesia. Nadie debería verse obligado a vivir con miedo a una persecución injusta.

Los animo a que se mantengan cerca de los miembros de sus comunidades parroquiales y los sacerdotes que les brindan atención pastoral.

Reconocemos que nuestro país está correctamente salvaguardado por los funcionarios encargados de hacer cumplir la ley; mantienen el bien común al protegernos a todos de la trata de personas, la explotación de los niños y cualquier otro delito penal contra la dignidad humana. Al mismo tiempo, abogamos firmemente por las políticas de inmigración que garantizan la protección de la vida, la libertad y la propiedad de todos los que llaman hogar a Estados Unidos de América, ciudadanos nacidos naturales y aquellos que trabajan hacia la ciudadanía por igual.

Si bien no existe una solución instantánea a los desafíos presentes en la política de inmigración, insto a todos en las comunidades parroquiales a unirse en la oración y la unidad social con los fieles inmigrantes bajo el liderazgo de los párrocos.

La Santísima Virgen y san José cuidaron al niño Jesús en el misterio de la huida a Egipto y su intercesión está con nosotros hoy. Oro con ustedes y por ustedes por la protección de Dios.

Que nuestro Señor bendiga a nuestro país con paz e inspire una reforma de inmigración integral que respete la ley y brinde oportunidades significativas para todos aquellos que deseen llamar a Estados Unidos de América su hogar.
